Crime

1 murder
every **31** minutes

1 violent crime
every **22** seconds

1 aggravated assault
every **37** seconds

1 robbery
every **1** minute

Crash

1 traffic fatality
every **12** minutes

1 traffic injury
every **12** seconds

11 law enforcement reported crashes
every **1** minute

1 fatal DUI crash;
at least one driver has BAC = .08+
every **39** minutes



Estimated Arrests

every **1** hour

- 167** DUI arrests
- 51** aggravated assault arrests
- 70** violent crimes arrests
- 14** robbery arrests
- 2** murder arrest
