

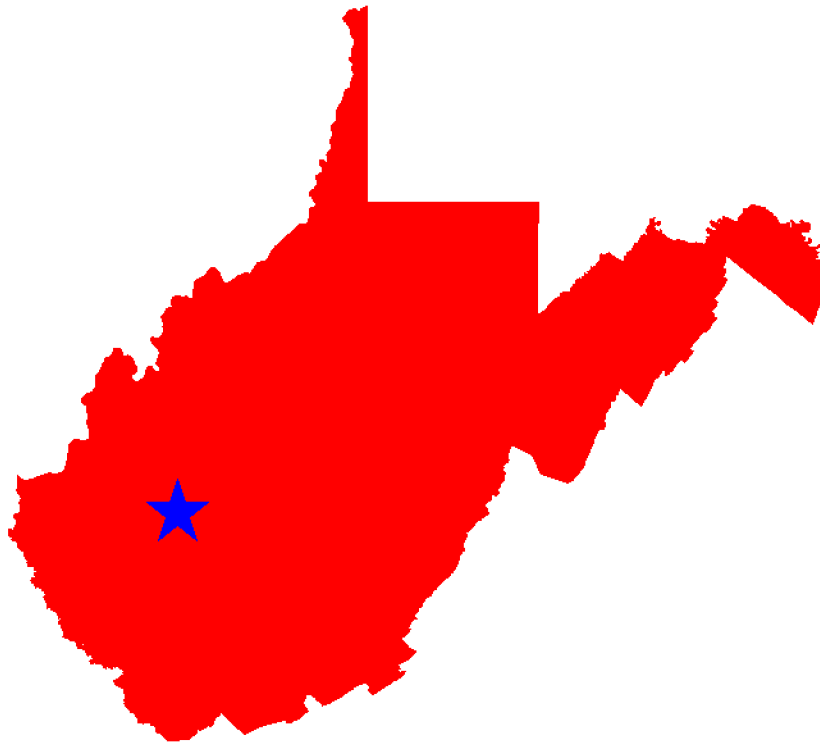

Unrestrained Passenger Vehicle Occupant (Age > 5) Fatality Data, West Virginia

The map below puts the fatality rate/100k population into four bins. Given the fatality rates for all counties in West Virginia in 2006, each county's fatality rate can fall in the lower, middle or upper third of rates or could be 0 (no fatalities).
