



### Unrestrained Passenger Vehicle Occupant (Age 5 and Older) Fatality Data, Utah

The map below puts the fatality rate/100k population into four bins. Given the fatality rates for all counties in Utah in 2007, the fatality rate for each county can fall in the lower, middle, or upper third of rates or could be 0 (no fatalities).


Fatality Rate per 100,000 Population as Compared to Rates for all Counties in Utah, 2007
