Vehicles made after 2007 have a **Tire Pressure** Monitoring System (TPMS) that will alert drivers when tire pressure is significantly **IOW** - about 25% below where it should be for safe operation.

IN 2019 THERE WERE 612 FATALITIES IN CRASHES WHERE A VEHICLE FACTOR OF "TIRES" WAS **REPORTED.** Follow these tips to help drive that number down.
