## **Additional Information**

Note: Each RI that is granted its RI registration must keep its business information on file with NHTSA current, accurate and complete by submitting revised information generally not later than 30 calendar days after the relevant business changes occur. If a RI intends to change its street address or phone number or discontinue use of a facility that was identified in its registration application, it must notify NHTSA not less than 10 days before such change and 30 days before annual renewal or discontinuance of such use, and identify the facility, if any, that will be used instead.
