Hi Jason,

We have been advised by the Customer Assistance Center that there have been a few ES 350 customers that have had the Lexus accessory all weather floor mats incorrectly installed. Upon inspection, it was found that the mats had been placed over the standard carpeted floor mats and not retained by the floor mat retaining hooks. The result has been that some floor mats have interfered with the movement of the accelerator pedal.

Would you please consider adding something like the following caution box and wording to the floor mat instructions? Please review any wording you want to use with TMS Legal before adding to the instructions.

/!\ CAUTION

When inserting the floor mat

Make sure the floor mat is properly placed and secured on the floor carpet. Do not place mats over other floor mats or other objects. If the floor mat slips and interferes with the movement of the pedals during driving, it may cause an accident.

Would you also please consider adding the work "hook" to steps 1 and 2? It would be good to have consistent wording with the Owner's Manual, which uses the word "hook."

- 1. Install retention clip/hook (P/N 00206-00801) into grommet hole provided in vehicle carpet.
- 2. Hook floor mat onto clip/hook first, then place mat into position.

Please let me know if you can help us with adding the caution statement and adding the word "hook" on

the instructions.
