Hi Chris,

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Please send me a copy of the final interim letter that was mailed in October. What we have on file does not look like a final. (See attached). Also, what date was the interim mailed? The following is what we have in the recall file. I need an update.

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Toyota is recalling certain model year 2004-2010 passenger vehicles. The accelerator pedal can get stuck in the wide open position due to its being trapped by an unsecured or incompatible driver's floor mat. A stuck open accelerator pedal may result in very high vehicle speeds and make it difficult to stop the vehicle, which could cause a crash, serious injury or death. Toyotawill notify owners of affected vehicles

to remove any driver's floor mat and not replace it with any other floor mat pending the development of model-specific remedies. Toyotawill mail a second notification to owners of affected vehicles notifying them of the free remedy when it is available. The first notice is expected to be mailed during October 2009 and Toyotawill advise NHTSA an estimate of the date when the remedy parts will be available. Owners may contact Toyotaat 1-800-331-4331, Lexus at 1-800-255-3987.
