- Incomplete Cut-away Chassis with GVWR ranges from 7,200lbs. through 14,500lbs. These vehicles are certified as completed vehicles upon completion of the installation of a secondary truck body. Examples of types of secondary truck bodies would include: Cargo Vans and Service or Utility Bodies.
- Alterations of completed motor vehicles with GVWR ranges from 7,200lbs through 12,500lbs. These vehicles are certified as altered complete vehicles upon completion of the alteration. Alteration example types would include: Truck mounted toolboxes, Ladder racks, Van Safety Partitions, Safety Lighting Systems and Truck Caps.
