This letter in in answer to your requirements for information necessary to decipher the characters contained in our vehicle identification number.

R.V. Classics, Inc. is in the business of manufacturing motor homes. In order to comply with your requirements for information necessary to decipher the characters contained in our VIN we are submitting the following method for deciphering them.

Our calculations for the 17 digit VIN numbers were established in the following manner:

- 2. On the outside of the frame 24" from the right front corner in the middle of the frame.
