All of our VIN number's will be starting with 1P9 this is the World Manufacturer Identifier Code that was assigned to my Bussiness. The 4th character will be the letter P (Plunkett) The type trailers we produce. The 5th character will the letter T which will stand for the series (trailers). The 6th Letter will depend of the body type which is lised above under Model #. 7th Character will depend on the length of the trailer again listed above under length. The 8th character will depend on the number of axles that certain trailer may have. The 9th digit will be of course the "Check digit"Number that number will be determined by carrying out the mathematical computation when the number is assigned.

The 10th digit will be the year model of that certain trailer (ex. 1985 the letter F, 1986 the letter G ect.). The 11th Character will be the number 1 because we have only the one place of bussiness, where we build trailers.


The 12th, 13th & 14th digits will be affixed because we build under 500 units. The 15th, 16th & 17th digits shall represent the number sequentially assigned by me as the trailers are built.

Example: 1P9PTAE26F1091001 would be the VIN number for a 16ft. Deluxe totem, 2 axle, 1985 model.
