Referring to the requirements of the U.S. Standard 115 on the vehicle identification number, we would like to inform you of two (2) modifications in the description of our vehicles:

- 1- In section 2 position 1, the letter M now means: bus shell instead of motor-home (M: bus shell).
- 2- In section 2 position 2, we are adding a different type of body that will be identified by the number 3. The description is monocoque construction 102 (3: monocoque construction 102).

Those modifications will be effective starting with our 1984 models.
