We submit the following development of our VIN for your approval:

Section I: (WMI) The first three characters; We have been assigned 1W9.

Section II: (VDS) The next five characters.

The first character will identify the type of trailer.

- C. Converter gear
- P. Pull trailer
- S. Semi trailer

The second character will identify the type of body.

- A. Flatbed trailer with hopper
- B. Hopper trailer
- C. Flatbed trailer
- D. Chassis only
- E. Self unloading trailer
- F. Converter gear

The third character will designate the length of the trailer in approximately ten foot increments.

1. 0 to 10'-0"
2. 10'-1" to 20'-0"
3. 20'-1" to 30'-0"
4. 30'-1" to 40'-0"
5. 40'-1" to 50'-0"
6. 50'-1" and over

The fourth character will designate the number of axles.

1. = 1
2. = 2
3. = 3 (etc.)

The fifth character will designate the G.V.W.. as per table in S4.5.2.

The check digit is the next character.

Section III: (VIS) The last eight characters.

The first character will represent the vehicle model year as indicated in Table II S4.5.3.1.

The second character represents the plant of manufacture.
D. Dixon, California

The third, fourth and fifth characters we have been assigned, O20. When combined with first three characters(1W9) identify manufacturer, make and type.

The sixth, seventh and eighth characters are a sequential number assigned in our production process.

Your approval of the foregoing will be greatly appreciated in order that we may start using the new system starting May 1, 1982.
