Per our telephone conversation of August 14, we hereby inform you of the information necessary to decode the VIN's on our second trailer, SWIV-L-TRAIL. Our letter of August 30, 1983, is on file with you, outlining our code for our first trailer, SWIV-L-FOLD. Characters 4, 5, 6 and 7 will change thus:

Character 4, describing type of trailer; utility -	U
" 5 " series name; SWIV-L-TRAIL-	T
" 6 & 7 " length of body in inches -	48

Characters 12 - 17 of the fourth section of the VIN, the serial number, will change to 092901, 12, etc.

Thus the full VIN for the first SWIV-L-TRAIL would be: 1DPUT4816E1092901.

Vehicle Identification Number Coding System for PONTIAC FIREFLY

GM VIN system is constructed in accordance with Part 571 - Federal Motor Vehicle Safety Standard No. 115 - Vehicle Identification Number - basic requirements and Part 565 - Vehicle Identification Number - Content requirements, Title 49 Code of Federal Regulations, and which consists of 17 characters of arabic numbers and roman letters.

Each decipherable content of characters and GM's own information is described as follows.
