

Gentlemen,

We are writing you in accordance with the requirements set forth by the final NHTSA Vehicle Identification Number Rule (FMVSS-115). The following information is supplied as deciphering information for the seventeen character VIN Motometeora will be using on its MOTOMARINA brand, Sebring model moped. This information is the same as that supplied to you previously except that this information covers units being manufactured with engines capable of less than 1 brake horsepower.

- 1) VIN First Section:  
CUNA has assigned "ZB2" as our unique manufacturer code.
- 2) VIN Second Section:  
1st character: M-Type of vehicle (motor driven cycle)  
2nd character: M-Line of vehicle (MOTOMARINA)  
3rd character: 1-Type of engine (Franco Morini M1)  
4th character: 0- Net brake horsepower 0.9 as per  
5th character: 9- SAE standard J245

- 3) VIN Third Section:  
1st character: F-Model year production 1985  
2nd character: B-Sole manufacturing plant located in Bologna, Italy

The ninth character in the VIN will be occupied by a check digit which is arrived at by using the prescribed calculations.

The last six characters of the VIN will be the serial number assigned to the vehicle sequentially during production.
