Thank you for promptly responding to my request for information on obtaining Vehicle Identification Numbers.

This is my interpretation of the VIN's that I would be using:

1st through 3rd - assigned 1D9

4th would be either U = Utility Trailer or  
F = Flatbed Trailer or  
L = Livestock Trailer

1 pg

5th would be either 5 = 5' wide trailer or  
6 = 6' wide trailer or  
7 = 7' wide trailer or  
8 = 8' wide trailer

6th and 7th - length in feet

8th - number of axles

9th - check digit

10th - model year

11th - 1 = Pavilion Plant

12th through 14th - assigned 152

15th through 17th - sequence of trailers built starting with 001

An example VIN for a 1989 6' x 16' tandem axle utility trailer would be:

1D9U61622K1152001
