Our sample VIN is 1H97C412~~9~~LL168001. Positions 1, 2, 3, 12, 13 and 14 were numbers issued by the SAE. We will be using the letter "T" in position 4 for "Tank". In position 5 we will be using one of the 4 following codes; "C" for chemical, "S" for sanitary, "P" for petroleum, "D" for dry bulk. Positions 6 and 7 are the length of the tank trailer. Position 8 will be "2" for 2 axles. Position 9 is the check digit. "L" is being used for 1990 model year in position 10. We are using the letter "L" in position 11 because our plant is in Lancaster, PA. Positions 15, 16 and 17 will be used for sequence numbers.

I am hoping you find this to your satisfaction. I am enclosing one of my cards in case you have any questions.
