VIN Coordinator

These are the characters that Deluxe Bumper Works will be using to denote "Series" and "Type" in the manufacture of trailers in accordance with Motor Vehicle Safety Standard No. 115.

"SERIES"

S (standard) denotes trailer that is manufactured for general sales at lower price than custom work.
C (custom) denotes trailer that is manufactured for special order and at higher price.

"TYPE"

F (flatbed) deck is built above wheels.
U (utility) deck is built between wheels and will have side rails to add strength to deck frame. Side rails can be left open, as a truss, or enclosed with sheet material to accommodate small or loose cargo.
E (enclosed) will consist of deck, sides, and top with or without sheet material and door.
C (car hauler) deck is built between or around wheels; with side rails or anchor points to secure automobile to.
S (stock) deck is built between or around wheels; sides will be covered with sheet material or slats. Can have top and will have gate or gates for animal and human access.
