Enclosed are three copies of a revised VIN Coding System Document covering 1995MY Suzuki Sidekick MPV's and the Samurai Truck Model. This document replaces the one forwarded to your agency this past June 3, 1994 as part of a group of Geo and Suzuki vehicle VIN Coding System Documents, our reference TAL-40526K1.

This revision reflects the addition of an additional Design Sequence reference number, the number 3 within the 7th character of the VIN which represents the 4 valve engine to be used in the 4-Door Sidekick 4WD model. The addition reads "3: 4 valve".

Please replace the previously submitted 95MY Suzuki Sidekick, Samurai VIN Coding System Document with this version marked (REV-8-8-94).



Vehicle Identification Number Coding System for
1995 Model Year SUZUKI SIDEKICK, SAMURAI

SUZUKI VIN system is constructed in accordance with Part 571 - Federal Motor Vehicle Safety Standard No. 115 - Vehicle Identification Number - basic requirements and Part 565 - Vehicle Identification Number -Content requirements, Title 49 Code of Federal Regulations, and which consists of 17 characters of arabic numbers and roman letters.

Each decipherable content of characters and SUZUKI's own information are described as follows.
