REFERENCE: VIN numbers for park model travel trailers and fifth wheel recreational vehicles - see our letter dated May 5, 1994.

Dear Ms. Proctor:

The VIN number system used by B & B Homes Corporation dba Teton Homes to identify recreational vehicles manufactured at 3283 North Nine Mile Road, Landmark Industrial Par, Casper, Wyoming, 82604 will be modified as follows:

Digits 1, 2 and 3 as assigned by SAE are 4M7 and were assigned to us by SAE coordinator, Cathy at Warrendale, PA during a recent request by our Director of Engineering, Marion Johnson. We will discontinue using 1T9 assigned to us previously because we will be building over 500 units per model year.

The 4th digit will be 2 if the unit is a Park model travel trailer or 3 if it is a fifth wheel and remains unchanged.

The 5th digit will be 0 for our Teton Royal model, 1 for our Summit Executive, 2 for our Teton Grand, 3 for our Teton Prestige and 4 for our Summit Supreme.

The 6th digit will be 0 for all body styles (and only (1) body style will be produced), and remains unchanged.

The 7th digit will indicate the nominal overall length of the unit using the appropriate letters and remains unchanged.

The 8th digit is for the axel configuration and remains unchanged. (2 for 2 axels and 3 for 3 axels and 4 for 4 axels.)

The 9th digit is the check digit and remains unchanged.

The 10th digit will be for the model year of the product and remains unchanged.

The 11th digit stands for the location of the Teton Manufacturing facilities in Casper, Wyoming. Since there is only one such facility, this digit will always be one (1) and this remains unchanged.

The 12th, 13th, 14th, 15th, 16th, and 17th digits will be our numerical sequential serial numbers and will begin with 008001 for the first unit produced in the new '94 year. In subsequent years, the sequential years, the sequential number will start as the next number after the last sequential number used for the previous model year. This number will not be affected by the different series with the next sequential number assigned as an order is logged without concern to series (models.)
