Please consider this document an ERROR STATEMENT regarding the following VIN number which appears on the 1989 VIN plate issued to Foothill Transit.

This is to clarify that the incorrect number is only on the VIN plate and not on the registration. A clerical error was made when assigning the VIN number at the time the original VIN number was generated.

This information will be submitted to the USDOT VIN error Database to be placed in USDOT Doc 1-2 N11-E. This database is available for law enforcement and State registration personnel to verify the correct VIN number.

A copy of this letter will be placed in the permanent record file of the transit agency.

It is our opinion that US CODE 1BUSC511 states that we can not change the VIN number once issued. However, we are required to issue a correction notice that will be placed ADJACENT to the original VIN tag on the exterior of the unit (Driver's side front of unit) NOTE: DO NOT REMOVE THE ORIGINAL TAG. DO NOT AFFIX THE CORRECTION NOTICE OVER THE ORIGINAL TAG).
