THINK North America, Inc. will produce the THINK City, a two-seat, fully-electric passenger car that is capable of highway speeds and has a driving range of 100 miles. The THINK City is constructed from a high-strength steel frame with an extruded aluminum upper structure. The exterior of the vehicle is composed of thermal-formed ABS plastic body panels. All vehicles are equipped with power steering, power brakes, power windows and airbags. The vehicle is powered by a lithium-ion battery pack mated to a 3-phase AC motor. The gross vehicle weight ratings (GVWR) of the vehicles produced will be approximately 2300 pounds.
